Police find and remove marijuana grow

A joint taskforce made up of Carver Police, Plympton Police and members of the Plymouth County Sheriff's department closed down an illegal marijuana grow located on the Plympton/Carver town line. After receiving a tip from an anonymous source police conducted surveillance and confirmed the report, officers observed several large marijuana plants in various stages of maturity. The plants were growing in a wooded area in a long abandon industrial area off Montello Street. The estimated street value is about \$10,000.00. Police conducted an early morning operation to eradicate the illegal grow. This incident remains under investigation if suspects are identified they could face charges of unlawful cultivation of a controlled substance.
